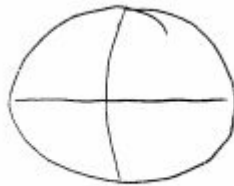

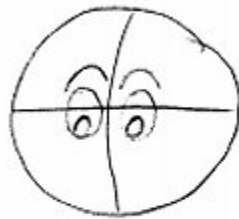


To begin we will draw a simple head like this.

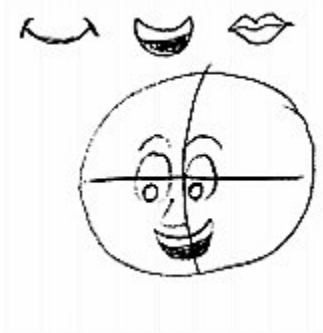
Make a circle. Any circle will do.. Like this!!!! (don't worry about the pencil marks, we are going to ink it and erase all the pencil later) Ok. I started off with a fat circle so it will be a fat face. Now draw a line from the top to the bottom (going a little to the left of center because he is looking to the left) and straight across the middle of the circle This will help locate the position of the eyes.



Now draw circles for eyes like this and ...mmmm better put a couple of eyebrows over those eyes. For now put the pupils on the bottom left as though he is looking down.



Let's make a little check like mark for the nose. (We will learn to make a variety of eyes and noses later)

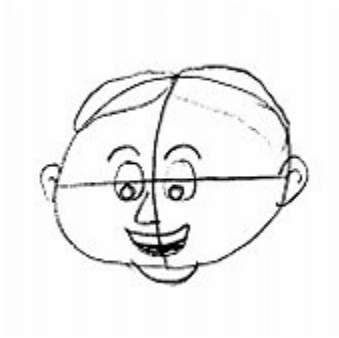


Look at these choices for a mouth and put one on your drawing.

I will choose the big smile. (Be sure the center of the mouth goes through the center line of the face)



The ears are at the same level with the eyes. and the hair starts about half way between the eyebrows and the top of the head.



Now put a little half circle for a chin and a couple of little lines to indicate the neck. aaaaaannnnnndddd trace with a pen, let dry and erase the pencil.



We now have just a basic caucasian man. Later we will make a woman and people from other cultures.
